## **International Admissions MSc in Management Programme**

---

The MSc in Management programme is a 2-year graduate programme taught in English and/or French concentrating on developing business acumen through specific experience and personal awareness. The aim of the MSc Program is not only to teach management techniques, but also to develop a business style. Using a wide variety of pedagogical and interactive methods and techniques, the courses focuses on developing decision-making abilities and creativity, the approach to taking risks. Students personally choose their courses and organise their curriculum including work placements and international mobility according to their personal and professional project.

EMLYON Business School has a specific procedure to select International Students in its MSc in Management Programme. The Selection is carried out by the “ Service des Admissions Internationales ” SAI - International Admissions Centre of the Paris Chamber of Commerce and Industry, also on behalf of four other French Grandes Ecoles.

### **Admission Procedure**

The admission procedure concerns applicants with a degree (eg: Bachelor’s degree...) obtained upon successful completion of at least three years of university education outside France.

Applicants with both a degree obtained outside France and a French degree must choose between the admission procedure reserved for applicants holding an international degree and the admission procedure for applicants with a French degree.

## **WRITTEN TEST**

---

### **GMAT (Graduate Management Admission test):**

Your original GMAT score must be received by the SAI before March 25th, 2009.  
The SAI will not accept any score after this deadline.

When registering, applicants should mention the SAI GMAT Program code: D14-M2-03.

N.B: GMAT copies and non-official scores will not be taken into consideration by the SAI.

The times of routing of the scores of ETS towards the SAI can take several weeks.

### **TAGE-MAGE (Test d'Aptitude aux Etudes de Gestion) :**

Inscriptions have to be done through SAI.

This test conceived by FNEGE (Fondation Nationale pour l'Enseignement de la Gestion des Entreprises) is organized by the SAI. Test duration: 2 hours.

This test will take place in March 2009 in one of the examination centres mentioned on your application form.

To prepare for the TAGE-MAGE, please visit [www.tagemage.com](http://www.tagemage.com).

If you have already taken the test TAGE-MAGE after the end of March 2008, you must transfer the official score directly to the SAI so that it will be taken into consideration.

On the basis of the application form and the written test, an Evaluation Committee will convene in order to draw up a list of applicants who will be invited for an interview.



## **ORAL TEST**

---

Interviews will be held in French or in English (30 minutes).

In the Selection Process, the oral test takes an important place. The Jury is composed of 3 or 4 persons, representing EMLYON Business School or other Business Schools, alumni and one or two representative(s) of companies.

The interview will evaluate the student motivation for an international management career, the reason for choosing to study in France and its adaptation ability.

Interviews will take place in May 2009 in the examination Centre mentioned in the application file. If the student took the GMAT test, the interview will be held in English, if not, it will be in French.

You have the right to access, alter, correct and delete the data concerning your personal registration (in pursuance to Article 34 of the Law « Informatique et Libertés »). Should you wish to exert this right, please contact the SAI.

## **G E N E R A L C O N D I T I O N S**

All applicants admitted via the SAI selection must also obtain their undergraduate diploma.

Applicants who will graduate in 2009 must provide to EMLYON Business School by November 1st, 2009 the official certificate of graduation or official certificate mentioning that they will graduate.

Otherwise the student will be excluded from the School.



## ***ELIGIBILITY/ADMISSION***

---

After this oral test period, the Evaluation Committee will draw up a list of admitted, admitted on a waiting-list, non-admitted students.

Students will find their admission result on EMLYON website.

The Committee decision is non revocable.

### **Application Deadlines**

March 1<sup>st</sup> 2009 → this concerns the applications outside Europe.

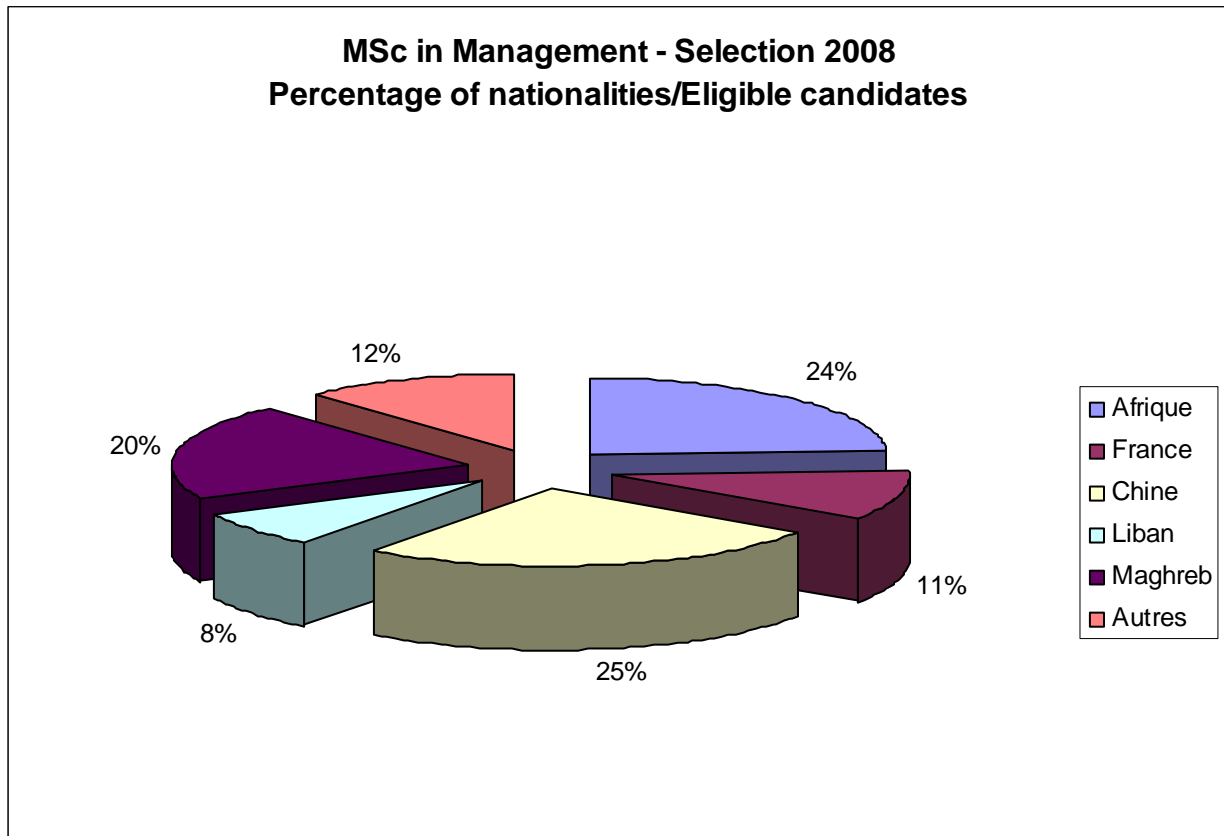
March 10<sup>th</sup> 2009 → this concerns the applications in Europe.

## **FINANCING YOUR STUDIES**

---

### **Plan your budget:**

- Tuition fees 2009/2010 to be paid to EMLYON per year:  
12,500€ + 300€ administrative fees for the European Union citizens  
10,200€ + 300€ administrative fees for the Non European Union citizens
- Students' corporation membership: 95 €
- A lap-top computer: between 1,500 € and 2,000 €
- Compulsory health insurance, third-party liability, etc.: 210 €
- Average of living expenses: 900 € a month.

For your information, you can now open while being in your country a bank account with our bank partners. (Please refer to the list of bank partners).

#### Requirements:

1. a copy of your admission letter.
2. a copy of your passport
3. your address in France

### **A – Tuition Fees**

Please note: a non-refundable deposit will be paid while sending your enrolment confirmation.

### **B – Possibilities to pay the tuition fees**

Upon your arrival you should provide the payment agreement ("*engagement de paiement*") duly filled in and signed together with the necessary documents (check, instalments receipt, proof of bank transfer...).

You can choose different types of payment:

#### **1. Full payment at your arrival at EMLYON**

##### → **Pay directly by check:**

If you pay by check make sure that it is issued in euros and payable in France. The check will be endorsed in October 2009.

##### → **Pay by bank transfer:**

When paying by bank transfer, you must provide a certificate of transfer from the issuing bank in order to prove your payment.



→ **Pay by international credit card:**

Please assure beforehand that the amount to be debited is not greater than the maximum amount permitted for a single transaction.

If you pay cash before October 30<sup>th</sup>, 2009 you will benefit a 1% discount on tuition fees.

Chinese students must make a complete payment of their tuition fees including their social security and insurance before arriving to Lyon.

You must contact Miss Liging CHEN ([chen@em-lyon.com](mailto:chen@em-lyon.com)) who is in charge of international relations at EMLYON Shanghai Campus. She will check with you all this documents in order to prepare your arrival to Lyon.

## **2. Instalments payments :**

A first payment will be requested on October 2009 (6 395€) and the balance (4 000€) is paid in 8 monthly installments of 500€ from November 2009 to June 2010.

### **BANK LOANS**

You can get a bank loan through EMLYON financial partners. If not, we advise you to contract a loan in your country of origin.

If the loan is granted, it must be transferred to EMLYON Business School no later than October 31<sup>th</sup>, 2009.

The bank will ask the international student to have a guarantor who lives and pays an income tax in France.

If the guarantor is not French he must prove that he/she is settled in France.

Any guarantor must provide the following documents to the bank:

- . an identity card: a copy of his/her spouse if married,
- . the last income tax statement,
- . the last three pay slips,
- . the last three bank account statements,
- . a current amortization chart.

Before your arrival in France, we invite you to contact our bank partners directly to secure a loan.
